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1 PURPOSE OF THE DOCUMENT

1.1 Introduction

The main purpose of this document is to create a register of processing activities in accordance with the provisions of REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter GDPR).

Article 30 of the GDPR requires data controllers who collect information containing personal data to create a register of processing activities.

Register of processing activities

- 1. Each data controller and, where applicable, their representative shall keep a register of the processing activities carried out under their responsibility. This register shall contain all the information detailed below:
- a) the name and contact details of the data controller and, where applicable, the joint data controller, the data controller's representative, and the data protection officer;
- b) the purposes of the processing;
- c) a description of the categories of data subjects and categories of personal data;
- d) the categories of recipients to whom the personal data were or will be disclosed, including recipients in third countries or international organisations;
- e) where appropriate, transfers of personal data to a third country or an international organisation, including the identification of that third country or international organisation and, in the case of transfers referred to in the second subparagraph of Article 49(1), the documentation of appropriate safeguards;
- f) where possible, the deadlines foreseen for the deletion of the different categories of data; g) where possible, a general description of the technical and organisational security measures referred to in Article 32(1).

5. The obligations referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 shall not apply to any company or organisation employing fewer than 250 persons, unless the processing carried out by that company or organisation is likely to result in a risk to the rights and freedoms of data subjects, is not occasional, or involves special categories of personal data referred to in Article 9(1) or personal data relating to criminal convictions and offences referred to in Article 10.

The following section defines the specific data that are processed and collected according to the processing activities previously analysed and detected in the organisation.
